Conditions of membership

In order to become a member, an individual or organisation must complete an application form, pay an annual subscription. The membership fee is waived for refugees and asylum seekers, fulltime students and those in receipt of benefit.

Entitlements and Responsibilities

Members may influence the policies and strategies of RMNS in the following ways:

- They are invited to attend the Annual General Meeting and any such meeting where major policy changes are to be proposed and discussed
- They are entitled to vote at any such meeting
- They are entitled to attend any meeting of the Trustees, by previous arrangement with the Chair, in order to give their views on any issue relating to RMNS policy or strategy.

Members are responsible for:

- Renewing their membership in response to an annual reminder
- Notifying the Membership Secretary of any change in their contact details
- **RMNS is a Company Limited by Guarantee (Charitable Company no: 0802686) and if it were to incur debts which could not be discharged from funds, members would be liable up to a limit of £1 per member.**

Termination of Membership

Membership is deemed to have lapsed if a member has not responded to an annual reminder for a period of two years. It may be renewed at any time by application from the member.

The Trustees reserve the right to terminate the membership of any individual or group deemed to have acted in a manner inconsistent with the aims or policies of RMNS. The decision of the Trustees in this matter shall be final.
